In this talk Dr Barbara Warnock will explore the various documents and collections that The Wiener Holocaust Library has relating to the Dunera and the experiences of those aboard in internment and afterwards. The Library's rich collections of documents and photographs relating to the lives of Jewish refugees from Nazism in Britain contain many relevant documents, official and unofficial, personal items and correspondence, diaries, and audio-visual material relating to this topic. These items can reveal a great deal about the transportation of the internees on the Dunera and their lives internment in Australia.

Dr Barbara Warnock is the Senior Curator and Head of Education at The Wiener Holocaust Library, where she has curated the exhibitions Jewish Resistance to the Holocaust, Berlin-London: The Lost Photographs of Gerty Simon, and Forgotten Victims: The Nazi Genocide of the Roma and Sinti, amongst others. She is the author of Berlin-London: The Lost Photographs of Gerty Simon, a Spectator Book of the Year in 2019, and a number of articles on Jewish refugee history and the Nazi persecution of Roma. She obtained her Doctorate in Austrian history from Birkbeck College, University of London, in 2016. She was for many years a history teacher and examiner.
